The Forum on Green Process Value Chains will be held in Xi'an, China on October 26, 2024.

Green Process Value Chains play an important role to mitigate global warming. In a more holistic view, existing process value chains from different industries need to be reevaluated on their potential for both, maximum carbon reduction and economic viability, if a broader scope is applied. Bringing different industries (automotive, mechanical, chemical, steel, aviation, semiconductor, cement, etc.) together might open a new field for collaborations which goes far beyond the manifold existing collaborations. Key Universities have already developed many new solutions in the field of Green Process Value Chains waiting for industrial use cases. Making use of those "sleeping" assets for various applications is one important goal of the Forum.

The Forum intends to provide a platform for industry and academia to learn about latest research, creating new solution routes and building new alliances which were not apparent so far. This will start a new era of carbon reduction innovations.
